Revisions to the contract documents published by the American Institute of Architects (AIA), perhaps the most widely used construction documents in the United States, are going to be released in the coming weeks.

At the end of April, the AIA is planning to release its decennial updates to the standard forms of agreement A101, A102, A103, A104 (previously A107), A105, A201 General Conditions, and A401 form of subcontract. The AIA is also introducing two new templates, the insurance exhibit and the E204 Sustainable Projects Exhibit, as well as revised agreements between the Owner and Architect and the Owner and Consultants.
